



LIVELIHOOD ENHANCEMENT AND ENTREPRENEURSHIP PROGRAMME (LEEP) 2022 REPORT SUMMARY

Overview

The Livelihood Enhancement and Entrepreneurship Programme (LEEP) is aimed at reducing poverty and improving the economic wellbeing of the vulnerable through sustainable entrepreneurial skills development, facilitating access to start-up input and improving productivity.

Particular emphasis is placed on youth, women, the physically challenged and deprived communities. Generally, the Programme has 3 major focal areas:

1. Skills set and Entrepreneurial Development Training
2. Agriculture business development and input support
3. Need-Based Business Start-up support scheme upon successful training sessions in the form of Equipment/Tools and Materials

2022 in Focus

In 2022, LEEP was implemented in Obuasi and Accra in the month of August. Specifically, the Skills set and Entrepreneurial Development Training aspect of the programme was carried out in collaboration with Pemsan Company Limited and Super A1 Company Limited. Beneficiaries were trained in the production of several products and in the provision of some services. It was expected that the trainees will use the knowledge to create start-up businesses for themselves. Trainees were given training manuals and awarded certificates for participation.

Trainees were taught in the following areas:

1. Bio-digester Construction
2. Fixing Car tracking Devices
3. Snail Farming
4. Emulsion Paint Production
5. Ointment Production
6. Shower Gel Production
7. Chocolate Powder Production
8. Brown Sugar Production
9. Washing Powder Production
10. Soap Production
11. Detergent Production
12. Weedicide Production
13. Fertilizer Production
